Defence Investiture Ceremony (Phase-1) Held

President Smt Droupadi Murmu conferred 10 Kirti Chakras (seven posthumous) and 26 Shaurya Chakras (seven posthumous) to the personnel of the Armed Forces, Central Armed Police Forces and State/Union Territory Police during Defence Investiture Ceremony (Phase-1) at Rashtrapati Bhawan in New Delhi on 5 July 2024. The awards were given to the personnel for displaying conspicuous gallantry, indomitable courage and extreme devotion to duty.

President Confers 94 Distinguished Service Decorations

President Smt Droupadi Murmu conferred 94 Distinguished Service Decorations to the personnel of the Armed Forces and the Indian Coast Guard during the Defence Investiture Ceremony (Phase-2) at Rashtrapati Bhawan, New Delhi on 19 July 2024. These decorations - 31 Param Vishisht Seva Medals (PVSMs), four Uttam Yudh Seva Medals (UYSMs), two Bar to Ati Vishisht Seva Medals (AVSMs), and 57 AVSMs - have been given to the personnel for distinguished service of exceptional order.

Prime Minister Pays Homage to the Bravehearts on Kargil Vijay Diwas

Prime Minister Narendra Modi on 26 July 2024 paid homage to bravehearts who made the supreme sacrifice in the line of duty, on the occasion of 25th Kargil Vijay Diwas at the Kargil War Memorial in Dras, Ladakh. The Prime Minister also witnessed the first blast of the Shinkun La Tunnel Project in Ladakh, virtually. Shinkun La Tunnel Project consists of a 4.1 km long Twin-Tube

tunnel to be constructed at around 15,800 feet on the Nimu – Padum – Darcha Road to provide all-weather connectivity to Leh. Raksha Mantri Rajnath Singh paid homage to the bravehearts at the National War Memorial in New Delhi. He was accompanied by the Vice Chiefs of the three Services and Chief of Integrated Defence Staff to the Chairman Chiefs of Staff Committee (CISC).

Rs 6.22 Lakh Crore Allocated to MoD in Regular Union Budget 2024-25

In the Regular Union Budget of Financial Year (FY) 2024-25, MoD has been allocated Rs 6,21,940.85 crore (approx. US \$75 Billion), the highest among the Ministries on 23 July 2024. While maintaining the allocation made to MoD during interim budget, the Government has made an additional allocation to the tune of Rs 400 crore on innovation in defence through the Acing Development Technologies Innovative with (ADITI) scheme. The allocation to MoD for FY 2024-25 is higher by approx. Rs one lakh crore (18.43 per cent) over the allocation for FY 2022-23 and 4.79 per cent more than allocation of FY 2023-24. RM Rajnath Singh exuded confidence that the capital outlay of Rs 1,72,000 crore will further strengthen the capabilities of the Armed Forces. He also hoped that the earmarking of Rs 1,05,518.43 crore for domestic capital procurement will provide further impetus to the 'Aatmanibharta' in defence.

Annual Defence Production Hits Record High Rs 1.27 lakh crore in FY 2023-24

The MoD <u>achieved</u> the highest-ever growth in indigenous defence production in value terms during Financial Year (FY) 2023-24. The value of defence production was Rs 1,26,887 crore, reflecting a growth of 16.7 per cent over the previous financial year.

Defence Secretary: Government Committed To Implement Industry 4.0/QA 4.0

Defence Secretary Giridhar Aramane said that the MoD is <u>committed</u> to handhold the defence ecosystem by implementing the Industry 4.0/QA 4.0. He was delivering keynote address at a National Level Seminar on Quality Reforms held virtually by Directorate General of Quality Assurance (DGQA) in association with SIDM on 9 July 2024.

India UAE Joint Defence Cooperation Committee Meeting Held

The 12th edition of the Joint Defence Cooperation Committee (JDCC) meeting between India and UAE was <u>held</u> in Abu Dhabi on 9 July 2024.

MoD Notifies Fifth Positive Indigenisation List

The Ministry of Defence <u>notified</u> the fifth Positive Indigenisation List (PIL) consisting of 346 items on 16 July 2024, with import substitution value worth Rs 1,048 crore.

Indian Navy's Annual Safety Review 2024 Held

The Annual Safety Review- 2024 (ASR-24), the 7th edition of Indian Navy's apex meeting on safety, was <u>conducted</u> at Southern Naval Command, Kochi on 19 July 2024. Adm Dinesh K Tripathi, CNS urged the senior leadership to strengthen the safety climate of Indian Navy.

24 Service Personnel Taking Part in 2024 Paris Olympics

Twenty four (24) Armed Forces personnel are among the 117 Indian athletes participating at the Paris Olympics, beginning 26 July 2024. Among these 24 athletes, 22 are men, including star Javelin Thrower Subedar Neeraj Chopra, and two women, which marks the maiden participation of female Service athletes at the Olympics.

India-Russia Military Technical Cooperation Meeting Held

The Working Sub Group on Planning of Military Cooperation of the India-Russia Intergovernmental Commission on Military and Military Technical Cooperation (IRIGC-M&MTC) <u>held</u> its 3rd Meeting on 23-24 July 2024 at New Delhi.

Armed Forces Respond to Landslides in Karnataka and Kerala

On 31 July 2024, the Indian Army intensified its HADR operation, to rescue people stranded after devastating landslides struck Wayanad on 30 July 2024. IAF helicopters undertook multiple sorties dropping relief material. Naval aviation assets provided support in transportation of SDRF and state administration officials. The Southern Naval Command dispatched a disaster relief team from INS Zamorin at Ezhimala on 30 July 2024. An ALH detachment in SAR configuration was deployed from Kochi to Calicut.

MoD's Divyangjan Expedition to Mt. Kilimanjaro Flagged Off

The Himalayan Mountaineering Institute (HMI), Darjeeling under the aegis of the MoD is <u>undertaking</u> a Divyangjan expedition from Kanchenjunga National Park to Mt. Kilimanjaro, the highest peak of the African continent during 2-20 August 2024.

MoD Inks **MoU** To Set Up Testing Facilities

The MoD has <u>signed</u> an MoU on 2 July 2024 to establish three state-of-the-art testing facilities in Chennai under the Tamil Nadu Defence Industrial Corridor - one each in Unmanned Aerial System (UAS), Electronic Warfare (EW) and Electro Optics (EO) domains. The MoU was signed under the Defence Testing Infrastructure Scheme (DTIS). The MoD on 30 July 2024 <u>inked</u> another MoU to set up three state-of-the-art testing facilities under the Uttar

Pradesh Defence Industrial Corridor (UPDIC). One facility will be established in Lucknow in Mechanical & Material (M&M) domain, one each in Unmanned Aerial System (UAS) and Communications domains in Kanpur.

DRDO Sanctions Seven New Projects under TDF Scheme

The DRDO has <u>awarded</u> seven new projects to industries under the TDF scheme for various requirements of the Armed Forces and aerospace & defence sectors on 11 July 2024.

DRDO Successfully Flight-Tests Phase-II Ballistic Missile Defence System

DRDO successfully <u>flight-tested</u> Phase-II Ballistic Missile Defence System on 24 July 2024. The Target Missile was launched from LC-IV Dhamra at 1620 hrs, which was detected by weapon system radars deployed on land and sea. The Phase-II AD Endoatmospheric missile was launched from LC-III at ITR, Chandipurat 1624 hrs.

First of Two Advanced Frigates under Construction Launched

The first of two Advanced Frigates under construction by Goa Shipyard Limited (GSL) for the Indian Navy, was <u>launched</u> on 23 July 2024 at GSL, Goa. The contract for building the two Advance Frigates was signed on 25 January 2019.

MoD and NSE Ink MoU to Facilitate Capital Market Access to MSMEs

The MoD and National Stock Exchange of India Limited (NSE) on 29 July 2024 signed a MoU to facilitate capital market access to MSMEs.

DAC Clears Capital Acquisition Proposals

The <u>Defence Acquisition Council</u> (DAC), under the chairmanship of Raksha Mantri on 29 July 2024 accorded AoN to the procurement of Advanced Land Navigation System (ALNS) for Armoured Fighting Vehicles (AFVs) of the Indian Army. The DAC also accorded AoN for procurement of 22 Interceptor Boats.

iDEX and AFMS Sign MoU

iDEX-DIO, the flagship initiative of MoD, has <u>signed</u> an MoU with Armed Forces Medical Services (AFMS) for the launch of Medical Innovations and Research Advancement (MIRA) on 30 July 2024.

The 13th edition of India-Thailand joint military Exercise MAITREE was conducted from 1-15 July 2024 at Fort Vachiraprakan in Tak Province of Thailand.

The 16th edition of India-Mongolia Joint Military Exercise NOMADIC ELEPHANT commenced on 3 July 2024, at Foreign Training Node, Umroi (Meghalaya).

INS Tabar Visits Casablanca, Morocco and Hamburg, Germany

Indian Navy's frontline frigate, INS Tabar arrived at Casablanca, Morocco on 8 July

2024 for a three - day visit. Later, upon departure from Casablanca, the two Navies will also undertake a PASSEX at sea. INS Tabar <u>arrived</u> at Hamburg, Germany on 17 July 24 for a three day visit.

Indian Air Force Participates in Ex Pitch Black 2024 at Darwin, Australia

An IAF contingent participated in Exercise Pitch Black 2024 conducted from 12 July 2024 to 02 August 2024. The exercise is a biennial, multi- national exercise hosted by the RAAF. The IAF contingent comprised over 150 highly skilled Air Warriors including pilots, engineers, technicians, controllers and other subject matter experts, operating Su-30 MKI multirole fighters, with the C -17 Globemaster and the IL-78 Air-to-Air Refuelling aircraft in combat enabling roles.

RSNF Trainees Complete Training Onboard First Training Squadron

76 trainees from King Fahd Naval Academy of the Royal Saudi Naval Forces (RSNF) <u>completed</u> their Afloat Training Course at First Training Squadron (1TS) of the Indian Navy on 18 July 2024.

Indian Army Contingent Participates in Exercise Khaan Ouest

An Indian Army contingent <u>participated</u> in the Multinational Military Exercise KHAAN QUEST conducted from 27 July to 9 August 2024 at Ulaanbaatar, Mongolia.
